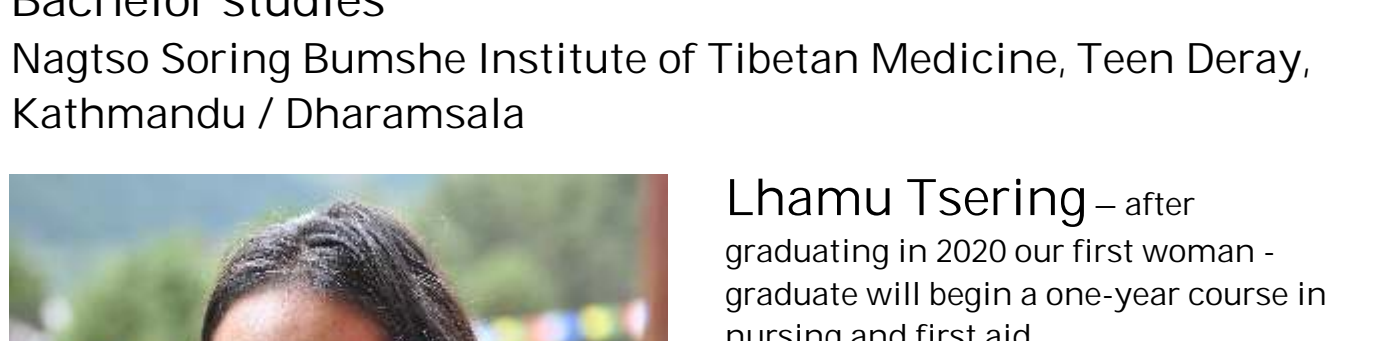

Lhamu Tsering – after graduating in 2020 our first woman - graduate will begin a one-year course in nursing and first aid.



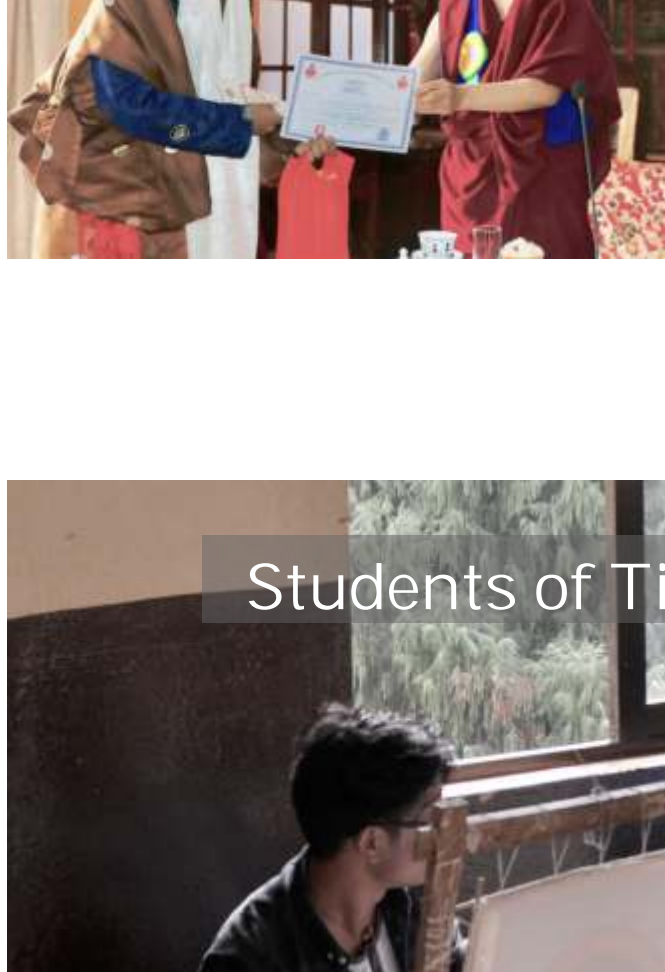
Dolma Gurung – has two years to prepare for her bachelor diploma.



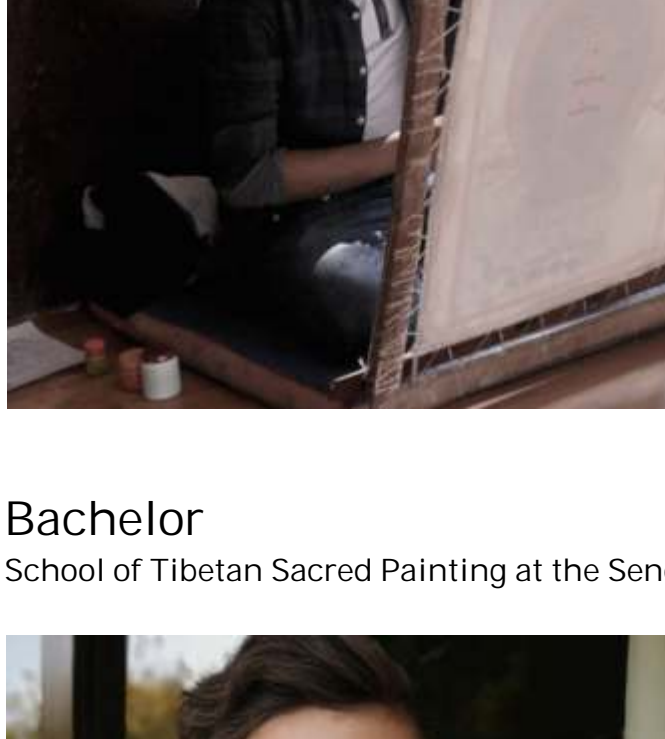
Ngawang Thupten – we look forward to his bachelor's degree next year.

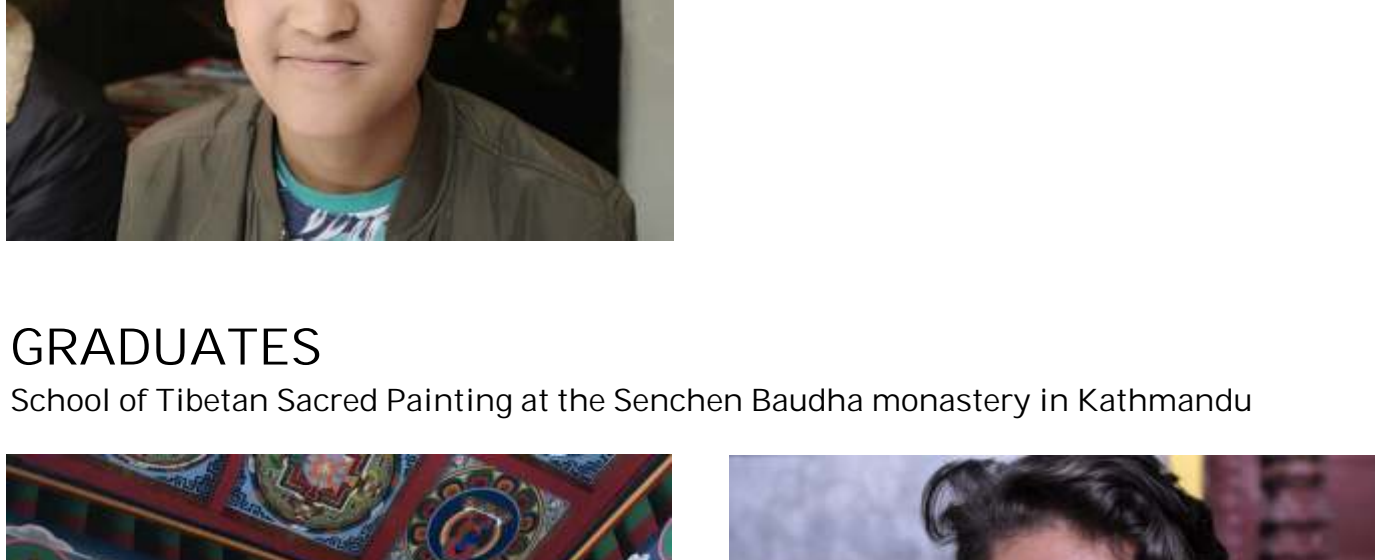

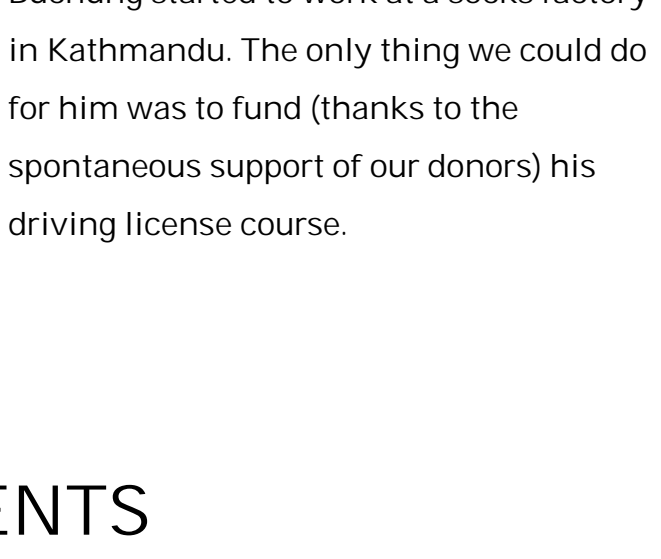
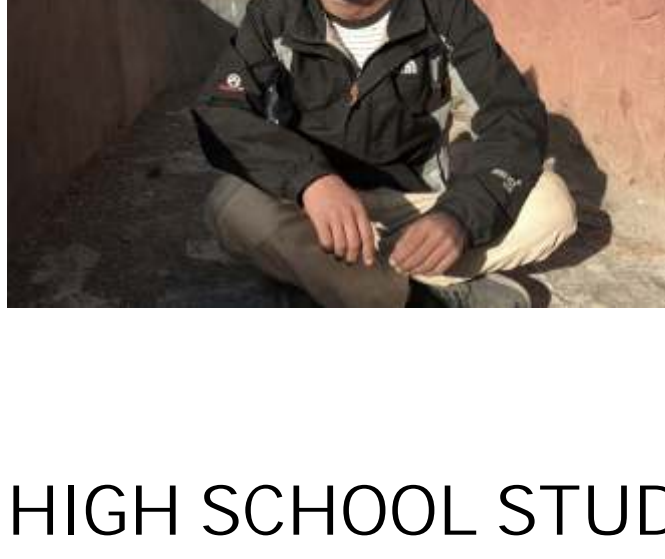

Sonam Wangdu, our first scholarship holder. He completed a basic painting course on time and finished one-year post-graduate internship. In summer Sonam started working on his own account.

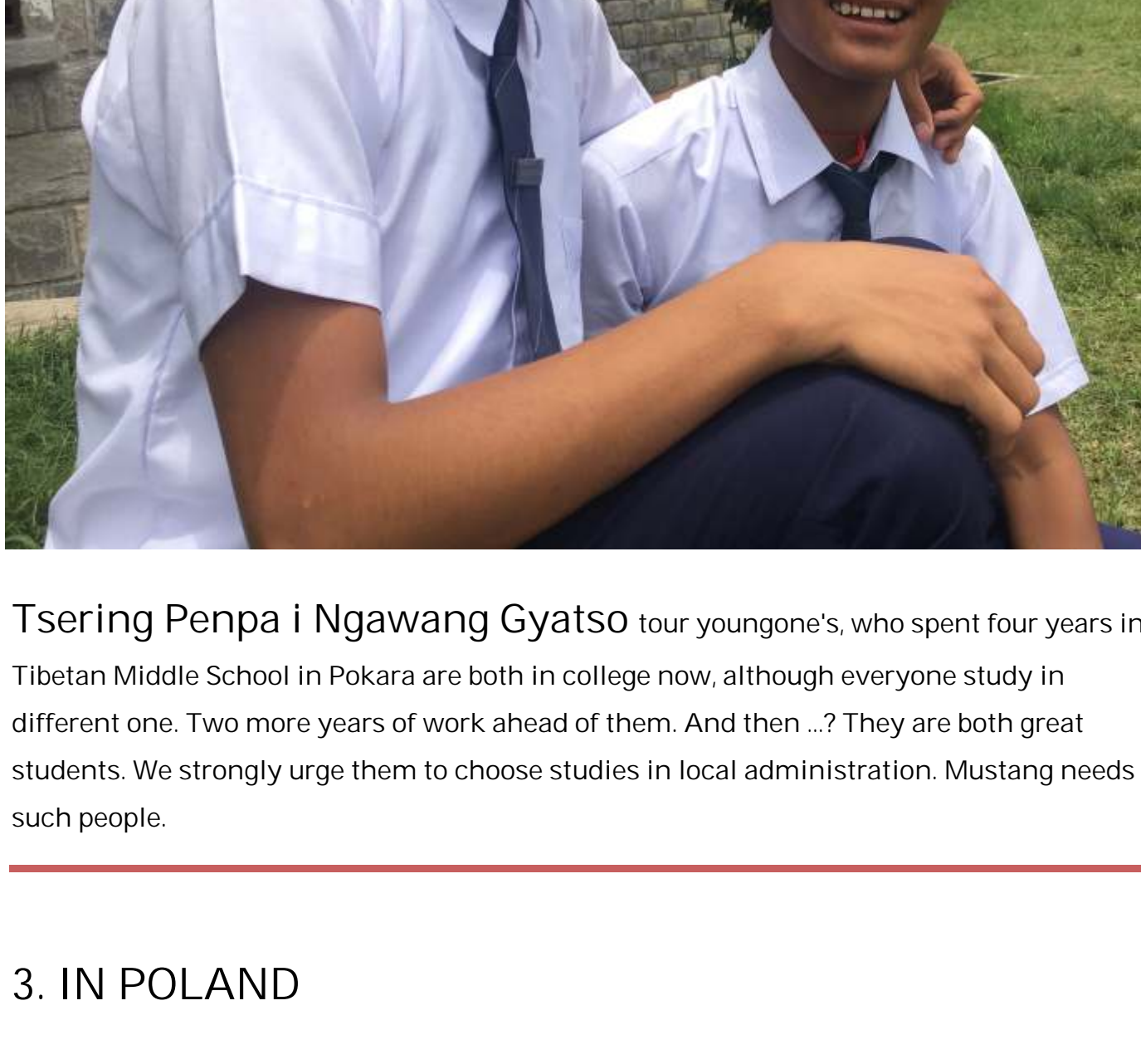

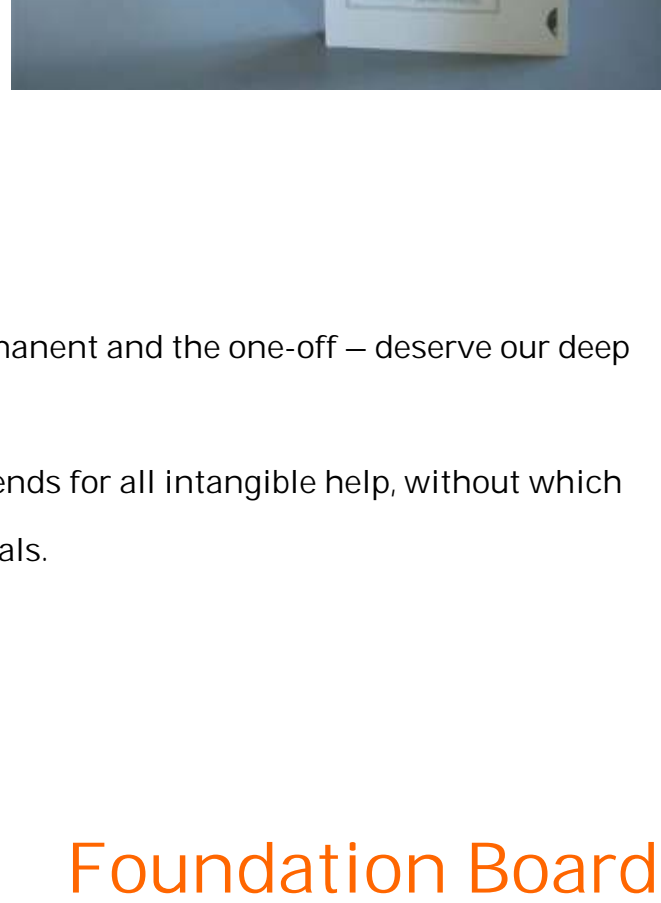
HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS
